### **Your Rights:**

#### **Whilst using Recharge I can expect to:**

- **To be in a safe environment**
- **To be treated with respect**
- **To be listened to**
- **To have my property respected**
- **To have fun**
- **To have someone from Recharge to talk to if I am worried about something or would like some extra support**
- **To have my voice heard and to be taken seriously with complaints and suggestions**
- **To be in a Coronavirus Safe environment**

## **Other People's Rights:**

**Whilst using Recharge I have rights as do others and to ensure these rights are met, we all must follow the rules mentioned below:**

- **Respect other young people, volunteers and staff**
- **I cannot bring in opened juice containers, but unopened containers are fine (Please see staff if you wish to bring in slushes, ice cream milkshakes etc.)**
- **I cannot bring in drinks which contain taurine or guaranine (Energy drinks)**
- **All rubbish must be put in the bins or appropriate recycling bins**
- **Respect the building and equipment**
- **No abusive or foul language**
- **No fighting or violent behaviour**
- **No gambling or betting**
- **No using the services whilst having or under the influence of Alcohol or Illegal Drugs**
- **To have any bags I bring into Recharge checked for Alcohol or Illegal Drugs if asked by Recharge staff or volunteers upon arrival to Recharge**
- **No waiting on the pavement outside the building, please wait at Civic Square until we are open**
- **No bullying**
- **I can bring in hot food in, but it must be eaten at the designated eating tables**
- **Make sure that Recharge holds up to date information on contact details and medical conditions**
- **To be aware of the Recharge system for behaviour**
- **To follow all coronavirus precautionary procedures including wearing face masks and regular hand sanitising while required**
